



Meeting of Interim Board of Management for St Seton's Secondary School

25th January 2022

Agreed Statement

At an ordinary meeting on 25th January 2022, the interim Board of Management:

- a) Expressed condolences to Adrienne Murphy and her family; Anna and Michelle Kelly and their family and the family of Marc Tormey.
- b) Received communication from CEIST and Le Chéile notifying the school of their decision to use the three available school campuses next September while awaiting the new additional building.
- c) Received the Principal's report detailing the various meetings which have taken place since the last Board meeting as part of building relationships between the three schools and work undertaken to progress the amalgamation.
- d) Discussed the 2022/2023 Enrolments: There have been 181 applications for 1st Year places for the 2022/2023 school year. To date, 131 places have been accepted.
- e) Reviewed the alternative accommodation options for St Seton's for September 2022. Discussion took place about the communication to staff, students, parents and the wider community of the decision to use the three campuses.
- f) Reviewed the building designs (unfinished) from the architect. The architect has committed to attend the next BOM meeting on 1st March to present the full set of three designs to the members.
- g) Agreed that the principal would commence a needs analysis in preparation for the recruitment of the Deputy Principals. There will be a special Board meeting on 15th February to initiate the recruitment process.
- h) Ratified the Anti-Bullying Policy.
- i) Appointed the Finance Committee. The members are Eddie O'Connor, John Barry and Sarah Green.
- j) The next ordinary interim Board of Management meeting will take place on 1st March 2022.
