# BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

The Stage 1 Submission from the Architect for the Additional Accommodation for St Seton's has been received by the Buildings Section of the Department of Education. A link to the report will be available on the St Seton's website and some visuals will be on display in the three schools later this week. The Stage I submission will now progress for review and assessment by the Department's technical team and we look forward to a meeting with them soon. Yesterday, the Department of Education committed to fund a full Building Condition Report to be carried out on the existing school buildings on the Le Fanu Road Campus and we will move swiftly to act on this development. The Emergency Works Applications required to be completed for opening St Seton's are progressing through the Boards of Management of St John's College De La Salle and St Dominic's College. These Emergency Works for the Health & Safety of Staff and Students are top priority.



## PARENTS'/GUARDIANS' COUNCIL

Another meeting for all Parents and Guardians will take place in St John's College on Wednesday, 5th October at 7pm. The Agreed Report from the meeting held on 21st September is available on the St Seton's website. 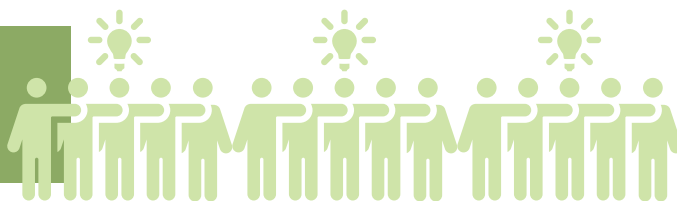
### GOOD NEWS
